


Fig.1: Front view of BIT

ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK

The Administrative Block is a grand and welcoming space that serves as the first point of contact for visitors, students, and faculty members upon entering the college. The block features a responsive and helpful reception desk that is staffed by knowledgeable individuals who are able to assist with queries and guide visitors to the appropriate offices or departments. The block also includes a comfortable waiting and lounge area, where visitors can relax and wait for their appointments. An electronic display is placed in this area, which keeps viewers informed about the latest developments and achievements of the college. Additionally, the block is adorned with a beautiful garden space at the front, and the entrance is designed with an eco-friendly approach, utilizing glass and other light-passing materials to allow for ample natural light and ventilation. This eliminates the need for artificial light or air conditioning inside the block. The entire Administrative Block is equipped with high-speed internet over LAN and Wi-Fi connectivity, and it is also under 24/7 CCTV surveillance for security purposes.




Fig.5: Training and Placement Department, BIT






Fig.6:Board Room, BIT






Fig.7: Principal Chamber, BIT






Fig.8:Staff Rooms, BIT




Fig.9: Auditorium, BIT




Fig.12:Open Stage, BIT

CANTEEN
