Bearys Groups of Institutions are conducting an event '**Clean Beach Green Beach**' program to spread awareness on the importance of Clean Beach and Green Beach.



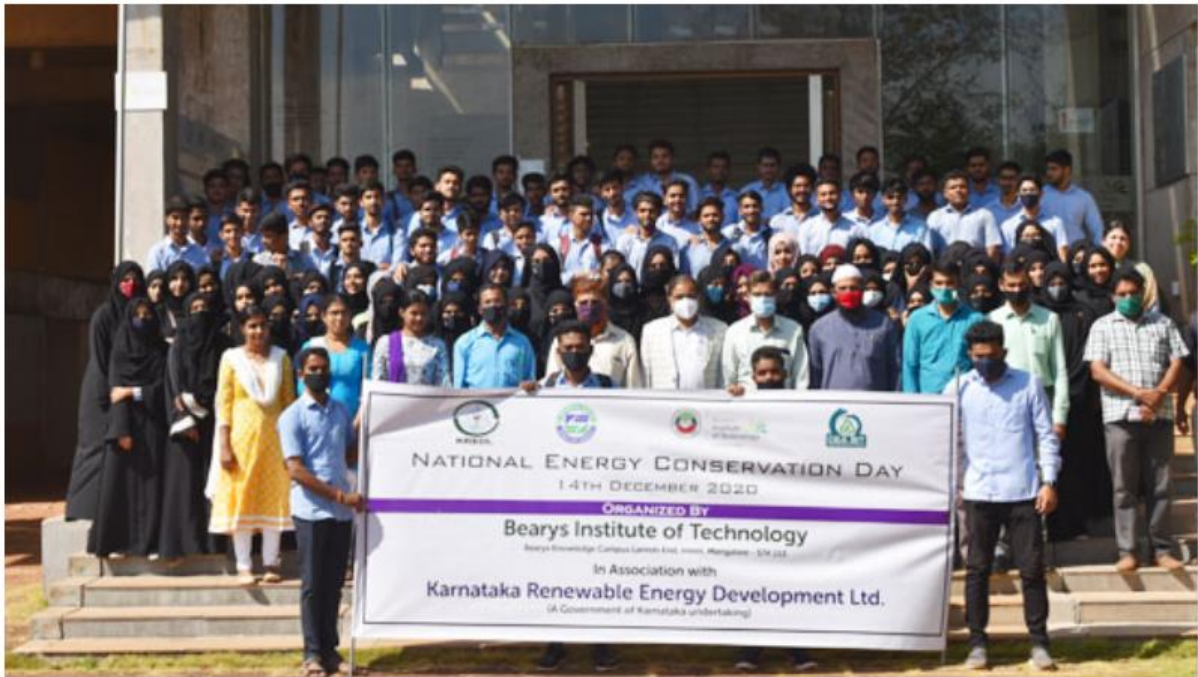


Fig 4. Participants for the program with the dignitaries


