Agenda 1: Preparedness for NAAC and OBE related work

The Member Secretary informed the house regarding the preparation about NAAC documentation work. He stated that the NAAC documentation work has begun and therefore all Coordinators of various departments have to submit the Excel templates at the earliest. Further, he stated that the Attainment of COs has been calculated by all Faculty and PO attainment has to be explained once again. Department meetings are also held to discuss the ways and means of achieving the high order POs.

Committee Members gave their opinion and insights over the OBE and NAAC preparation at the Institute level and also requested all Faculty to know the calculation of COs and POs thoroughly. They emphasized on the need for going for accreditation at the earliest.

Agenda 2: Review on improving admission in Core Branches and Academic Performance

The member Secretary presented the Admission related initiatives to the Committee and the following observations were made:

- 1. Committee appreciated the efforts of Faculties in maintaining consistency in admissions in Circuit Branches and requested to focus on Core Branches like Civil and Mechanical Engineering.
- 2. Academic performance of students was discussed and presented to the panel. Academic performance of students in Civil and Mechanical and also in 3rd Semester was found to be not upto the mark and discussed measures to be taken to improve the performance in SEE. Committee members opined that students should have a solid foundation from 1st year itself and extra effort should be taken in this regard.

Agenda 3: Review on Placement Statistics

Member Secretary presented the Placements statistics for 2021. Mr. Afzal pointed that the placements could be improved. He stated that encouragement should be given by all to improve the placements and only when proper training is given to write Aptitude Exams, Mock Interviews, the numbers will improve.

Agenda 4: Various Initiatives in the College

- 1. Principal informed the house that new B.E Programmes on Artificial Intelligence and Data Science will be starting from the coming academic year.
- 2. The Green walkathon initiatives of the College was appreciated by all Members and the very idea and implementation of the Pro-Nature related activities amongst the Faculty is a good initiative.
- 3. Committee members requested Faculty to start publishing in Good Quality journals and also to apply for funding through DST, VGST.

4. Members appreciated the 3 Day workshop conducted on National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020: Implementation and challenges, from 27th to 29th September, 2021.

Agenda 2: Review on Academic Performance

The member Secretary presented the Academic Statistics to the Committee and the following observations were made:

- Committee observed and appreciated the efforts of all Faculty and content delivery of all the courses. The committee observed that the results for the ODD semester 2020-21 are good and commended the efforts of all Faculty and stakeholders in achieving the same.
- 2. The third Semester results were poor as compared to the Results of 5th and 7th Semester and Committee members requested to ensure that extra coaching is given to students of 3rd semester so that they are sound in their basics and learn effectively. The Principal assured that steps would be taken to improve the pass percentage of students.
- 3. The Committee enquired about AICTE 100 activity points. The Principal mentioned that due to the Pandemic, the activity points has been reduced to 50 points and he discussed the ways and means through which students would be achieving the points. Green walkathon and Beach Cleaning Activities would also be added to the list of activities besides extension activities in schools and surrounding villages. The committee appreciated the efforts.

The committee members appreciated the efforts taken by the College in conducting Value added Courses during Covid time for the Students and said it will definitely enhance the skills of students and make them employable.
